

# **EUROPEAN TEAM CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP**

# BATUMI (GEORGIA) 23 October – 3 November 2019

## **GENERAL REGULATIONS**

## 1. Venue & Schedule

The championships will be held in 5 hotel "Sheraton Batumi"

Time of Ceremony is preliminary, changes are possible.

## 2. Participation & System and Rate of Play

- Each ECU member has the right to enter one team of four players and one reserve in the open competition and one team of four female players and one reserve in the women's competition.
- The European Team Championship shall be played according to the Swiss System in 9 rounds, with
  one open section and one section for the women's team, each considered as separate competitions.
   According to ECU and FIDE rules, the time control will be 90 minutes for 40 moves + 30 minutes for
  the rest of the game, with 30 seconds increment for every move played starting from the move on.

## 3. Registration & Fee

- The deadline for the registration on Monday, 21 of August, 2019
- The national federations are kindly requested to fill the registration\_accomodation\_flight form which
  can be found on the official website www.euro2019.ge
- Please, notice that registration form must be submitted by the national federations only.
- Team will not be registered until all their registration details have been satisfactory submitted.
- Not later than August 21, 2019, each participant federation shall confirm the exact team lists with all names.
- Late registrations: applications received after August 21, 2019 may be refused or be subjected to an additional entry fee (at least equal to the reimbursement of extra costs incurred by the organizers).
- For each participant/coach/accompanying person every national federation has to pay the registration fee of 100 Euro to the organizers. This fee is obligatory for all and includes registration and accreditation badges as also transportation from and to Batumi airport.
- The fee should be paid not later than August 21, 2019.

#### 4. ECU Fee

- In accordance with ECU regulations, an entry feed of 260 Euro is required for each open national team and another 260 Euro for each women's national team.
- According to the ECU regulations, the entry fee shall be paid by the federations to the ECU bank account before or at the start of the competition.

#### 5. Visa Information

- About 90 countries citizens do not need Georgian visas, including the EU and almost all European countries, former Soviet Union countries including Russia, Israel, Turkey and many others. They will get free of charge stamp in Batumi, Kutaisi or Tbilisi airport.

- The rest of the countries needs Georgian visas.

- The cost of visa is about 20 USD.
- Those who need visas must submit their data the latest on 21 of August, 2019

## 6. Airport & Transportation

- The organizer will provide transport services of all participants on October 23<sup>rd</sup> as well as the
  departure transfer on November 3<sup>rd</sup>. If any delegation arrives one or two days before the competition
  or leaves later the same service will be provided.
- Travel from Batumi airport (2 ways) to hotels is free of charge.
- Travel price from Kutaisi airport (2 ways) to hotels (120 km) is for each person 50 Euro.
- Travel price from Trabzon airport (2 ways) to hotels (160 km) is for each person 70 Euro.
- Travel price from Tbilisi airport (2 ways) to hotels (360 km) is for each person 80 Euro.
- Players who make private transport arrangements and clearly indicate this in the registration form will be fully responsible for any problems they experience during arrival or departure.

## 7. Hotel and Meals

- Reservations will be done on the "thirst come first served" basis.
- According to the article B.14.5.1 of the ECU tournament regulations the participating teams shall stay in the official hotel for the championship. Bookings are possible only through the Organizing Committee.
- Reservations and payments for the hotels must be made before August 21, 2019 (registration deadline).
- Accommodation with full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner), for per person per day costs:

- Distance between Sheraton and Inturist is 400m.
- The Organizing Committee will not complete hotel booking until payments have been made to the organizers, not later than August 21, 2019.
- After this date, the advance payments are not refundable in case of cancellation.

## 8. Payments

- After the registration form has been filled in, sent to the organizer and approved by the organizer, the
  national federations will receive invoices for bank payments. The invoices will contain all necessary
  details for the bank payment.
- A sender must pay all bank commissions.

#### 9. Prizes

- The First three teams in the open and women's sections will each receive cup and prize money 32 000
  Euro in total. Each member of the winning team (players, reserves and captain) shall receive a gold medal
  and diplomas. The members of the second and third-placed teams shall each receive a silver and bronze
  medal and diplomas respectively.
- The best performing players in the open and women's sections on each board (totally 8 players) will receive medals and prize money 4 000 Euro in total. Performance shall be calculated as per the ECU tournament rules. Second and third winners of both sections will receive silver and bronze medals.
- All players and team captains must take part in the opening and closing ceremonies. If a member of a
  prize winning team (player or captain) is absent during the closing ceremony, the related money prize
  will be reduced by 20%, with a minimum of 100 Euro.
- The money prizes will be transferred to the bank accounts of the winning team's through ECU.

## 10. Tie – Break System

The order of teams that finish with the same number of match points shall be determined by application of the following tie-breaking procedures in sequence, proceeding from a, b, c to d the extent required:

a. By the sum of Sonneborn – Berger points, which is calculated as follows: match points of each

points, excluding the opponent who scored the lowest number of match points, multiplied by

the number of board points scored against each opponent respectively. The highest number

wins; In case of two or more opponents with this same number of match point the lowest results

of multiplication should be excluded.

b. By the number of board points won, the highest number wins;

c. By the sum of the board points of all team's opponents, the highest number wins;

d. By the sum of the board points of all opponents defeated plus one half of the board points of all

the opponents with which a tied result was achieved, the highest number wins.

11. Special Competition Rules

The ECU Rule related to dress code will be applied at this competition.

Players may only agree to draw after the 30 moves has been made by black. Players violating this rule will

be forfeited.

Any player who has not arrived at the board 15 minutes after the start of the session shall lose the game.

All team captains shall be Fide licensed trainers.

The appeal submission fee is set at two hundred euros (200 Euro).

The chairman and 2 members of the Appeals Committee and Chief and deputy arbiters of the

competition will be announced by ECU no later than 1 September 2019. Two more members of the

Appeals Committee will be elected in the captains meeting by the team captains.

The Fide Anti-Cheating guidelines are valid for all European Championships. During European Team Chess

Championship, random AC inspection are possible.
